Respiratory Syncytial Virus
[RSV]

is a common cause of coughs and colds.

It usually gets better by itself, but it can be serious for some babies and older adults, causing significant breathing difficulties

There is now a vaccine for RSV

the surgery are offering it to

- pregnant women who are at least 28 weeks pregnant
- adults of 75 to 79 years

Have you had your Shingles vaccine?

It is available for

- adults aged 65-79 who have not had it before
- individuals aged 18 or over with a severely weakened immune system

It can significantly reduce your risk of getting shingles or having more severe symptoms if you do get it.
